



Discover Scuba Diving - Cruise Visitors.

Please read these details carefully. Contact us with any questions you have.

What is Discover Scuba?

Your Discover Scuba Dive starts with a short session on a shallow platform suspended under our boat. We start by breathing on scuba, and then we move on to learning a few safety skills to help us while we are diving. We will teach you to operate your BCD, remove and replace your regulator underwater and also to clear water from your mask.

After that we complete 1 or 2 dives from our boat to a **depth of 40ft** (12M).

What previous experience do I need?

You did not need to have experienced scuba before. **However please be aware that this experience takes place in the open ocean and we go to a depth of 40ft.**

You do need to be:

- Comfortable in deep water.
- Comfortable in light ocean waves.
- Comfortable swimming in the open ocean.
- A competent ocean snorkeler.
- Medically fit for Scuba (see questionnaire).

If you are unsure as to whether you will enjoy scuba, then prior to your cruise, why not try a pool discover scuba with a local dive centre at home?, this is a great way for you to enjoy a fuller experience in the ocean.

Medical Statement.

Prior to your Discover Scuba you will need to complete a medical statement; this is available at the end of this document. You need to be able to answer "no" to all the medical questions on the form. If any of your answers are a "Yes" then you will need a specific sign off from your doctor to be able to dive.

Course Costs.

Discover Scuba including all taxes and CC fee is US\$ 137.35 for a single dive, the second dive is entirely optional and the cost is US\$ 31.30.

Both dives are completed in a single boat tour.

Transport

We provide complimentary transport from the cruise port. Meeting time is normally **8:15 AM LOCAL TIME**. It is important that you arrive on time for pickup.

Cameras Underwater.

- You may bring a Go Pro or small underwater camera with you on your dive.
- Please ensure that you have a means of firmly securing your camera to you, (Wrist Strap or Lanyard). Chest, Head and Wrist mounts do not work well when diving.
- Please remove any "floating" attachments from the camera, as you are diving, rather than snorkelling, you do not want your camera to float.
- Please make sure that your camera has a depth rating beyond 40ft (12M).

How to Book:

1. **Read the requirements in this document.**
2. **Check the medical questionnaire; make sure all answers are a specific "NO".**
3. **If you have not already done so, contact us to check availability.**
4. **We will ask you to confirm by email that you have no medical issues.**
5. **Pay for your first dive at the time of booking. (Second dive is optional and paid on the day).**

Please book early, places are limited. When you book we require the following:

- Name of each diver.
- Their Jacket or sweater size.
- Age if they are under 18.
- Details of any previous scuba experience.

We will confirm your pick up time at the cruise port (**normally 8:15am Local Time**), **please arrive promptly.**

Cancellation Policy

We operate a 7 day cancellation policy, for cruise passengers we will also refund your deposit if your ship fails to dock in St Kitts.

Medical Questionnaire:

If any of these items apply to you, we must request that you consult with a physician prior to participating in scuba diving. Please send us a copy of your Doctor's sign off when booking.

- Do you currently have an ear infection?
- Do you have a history of ear disease, hearing loss or problems with balance?
- Do you have a history of ear or sinus surgery?
- Are you currently suffering from a cold, congestion, sinusitis or bronchitis?
- Do you have a history of respiratory problems, severe attacks of hay fever or allergies, or lung disease?
- Have you had a collapsed lung (pneumothorax) or history of chest surgery?
- Do you have active asthma or history of emphysema or tuberculosis?
- Are you currently taking medication that carries a warning about any impairment of your physical or mental abilities?
- Do you have behavioural health, mental or psychological problems or a nervous system disorder?
- Are you or could you be pregnant?
- Do you have a history of colostomy?
- Do you have a history of heart disease or heart attack, heart surgery or blood vessel surgery?
- Do you have a history of high blood pressure, angina, or take medication to control blood pressure?
- Are you over 45 and have a family history of heart attack or stroke?
- Do you have a history of bleeding or other blood disorders?
- Do you have a history of diabetes?
- Do you have a history of seizures, blackouts or fainting, convulsions or epilepsy or take medications to prevent them?
- Do you have a history of back, arm or leg problems following an injury, fracture or surgery?
- Do you have a history of fear of closed or open spaces or panic attacks (claustrophobia or agoraphobia)?
